

Portfolio Website Assignment

With this assignment you are going to create an interactive website for your portfolio.

You're going to gather your existing artwork and samples of your creative and other CG work and place them in a galleried website made in Adobe Dreamweaver.

IF it's small enough, and you feel ready to post it, we MAY upload it to your AIM OLS provided web server.

Otherwise, we'll content ourselves to gathering it all in a folder to drop off, present and take with us.

More and more frequently professional studios, employers, clients and generally anyone else who wants to give opportunity, are looking to find your work on the web. It seems as though they can't be bothered any longer with putting a DVD in a player.

So, to facilitate that, you should at least know the basics of one of the easiest website development tools out there – **Dreamweaver**.

What you need to do, (at minimum):

1. Have a home page, (*index.html*)
 - a. This should have at least two options:
 - i. A link to a **Career Path** page for examples of the kind of work you want to do, (see "Flow Chart").
 - ii. A link to a **Galleries** page for examples of your work.
2. Your **Gallery** page should have thumbnails of your work
 - a. Each of those thumbnails should link to a larger image of your work.
3. You should have a simple menu on both your **Career Path** page and your **Galleries** page that will take us to the main pages of your site.
 - a. You should repeat that navigation menu on each large image from your gallery.
4. You should also have a **Bio** or **About Me** page in your website.
5. You should have **Contact Info** and/or an **e-mail** button on your website
6. You MUST save EVERYTHING in a folder labeled *Lastname_Firstname_Website*
 - a. The entire folder should be dropped off in the appropriate folder on the Drop Off Drive by the **beginning** of class, 2nd class, week 06.
